Christmas Sunday, December 25, 2016 Luke 2:17-20

When they had seen Him, they spread the word concerning what had been told them about this child, and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds said to them. But Mary treasured up all these things and pondered them in her heart. The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things they had heard and seen, which were just as they had been told.

God's Word through Luke beautifully evokes the range of awestruck responses to the Holy One and the Sign of His lying in the manger: from the shepherds' joy and subsequent evangelism and praise, to Mary's pondering of her newborn son's being *THE* Son. Here He was: born as one of us, a fragile baby, wrapped in cloths there in the manger.

Our modern-day Christmases often tend to be filled with everything and everyone other than Jesus. May you turn from that temptation and fix your eyes and heart on Jesus. How is He inspiring you to respond to Him? In worship? In evangelism? In contemplation? I hope and pray your Christmas is fruitful with each of these faithful, joyful responses.
