EPEATEDLY APPLIES THE MOST BASIC HARVEST/STEWARDSHIP TRUTHS:

What you sow now, you will reap in the future.

h(fullness) or absence of faith(fullness) as sowers/stewards in this life directly relates to our eternity in Hell or Heaven.

sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, while whoever sows generously will also reap generously.

God loves cheerful givers; cheerful givers love (believe) God.

[As Jesus said/Luke 16:10] "Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much, and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with much. So if you have not been trustworthy in handling worldly wealth, who will trust you with true [i.e. heavenly] riches?

(1) **PERFECT JUSTICE** Galatians 6:5&7
