Again in verses 49-50. Mark says. When they saw him walking on the sea they thought it was a ghost, and cried out, for they all saw him and were terrified. Immediately he spoke to them and said, "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid."

And Moses said, "I will turn aside to see this great sight, why the bush is not burned." When the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called to him out of the bush, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am." Then he said, "Do not come near; take your sandals off your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground." And he said, "I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob." And Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look at God. (Ex. 3:3-6)
