Our Mission Partnership with CMJ Israel

God has blessed and called First Presbyterian Church Starkville to partner for the past two years with the Church's Ministry Among Jewish People (CMJ) and, specifically, with CMJ's ministries in Israel (CMJ Israel). The mission of CMJ Israel is to represent the Love of Yeshua (Jesus) in Word and deed with Jewish people and Gentiles living in the Land of Israel (including Palestinians & other Arabs), as well as with Jews and Gentiles visiting Israel from abroad.

Founded in 1809, CMJ has, further, been active in the Land of Israel since the 1820s. That makes CMJ Israel the oldest continual Protestant evangelical ministry working with and among both Jewish people and Gentiles in the Land.







Welcome The Reverend Canon Daryl Fenton and The Reverend Pedro Santos

On Friday, FPC Starkville was honored to introduce to our Central South Presbytery (EPC) The Reverend Canon Daryl Fenton and The Reverend Pedro Santos, and this morning, we welcome Daryl and Pedro to our Lord's Day worship services. We are especially blessed to have Rev. Canon Daryl Fenton preach God's Word, as well as to hear Good News mission updates from Rev. Pedro Santos.

As of January 1, Rev. Canon Daryl Fenton became Executive Director of CMJ Israel in Jerusalem. Prior to that, he served as the Executive Director of CMJ in the United States from 2011 to 2019. A graduate of Wheaton College, Wheaton, Illinois, and Trinity Seminary, Ambridge, Pennsylvania, Daryl has served in a number of leadership roles for the Anglican Church Network and in evangelical mission, and – in addition to his work for CMJ, Daryl continues to serve as Canon to the Middle East for Archbishop Beach and the ACNA.

Reverend Fenton is married to Sandy Fenton. They have two grown children, Joshua and Amanda, and grandchildren Jacob, Ethan and Alana.

Rev. Pedro Santos (originally from Brasil) for the past two decades has served as Director of the Beit Immanuel Ministry Centre in Yafo/Jaffa (employing the historic Ustinov-House facilities to house the CMJ Cultural Centre for the Tel Aviv area, a Bed & Breakfast serving thousands of visitors annually from multiple countries, and the meeting and worship place for the weekly services of both the Messianic Jewish and Arab communities in the larger Yafo-Tel Aviv.)

With a strong emphasis on reconciliation, Rev. Santos and his team work closely with the local Jaffa Arab Christian congregation, and they disciple Jewish and Arab men and women who, in turn, impart the values and discipline of a faithful, Christ-centred lifestyle.

Rev. Santos is married to Annu, a Finnish national whom he met in Israel. Together, they have two sons, Daniel 22 and Yonatan 18.
