- Nancy Lifer (Vice President of Starkville Habitat for Humanity and Chair of the Family Selection Committee) joined FPC's Joel Downey and other Habitat leaders in bringing the great news of the verysurprised OCH employee, Erica Rice, that she had been selected to become a Habitat partner and homeowner.

- FPC and our Men's Cooking Team hosted the Ecumenical, Internacial Christian Men's Prayer Team, together with Dr. Eddie Peasant, Superintendent of the Starkville-Oktibbeha County Consolidated School District as the faith-based Kick Off to the School Year on July 25.

- Charlie Weatherly and I represented our church's outreach, as we joined the Ecumenical Prayer Team in greeting and praying for all teachers and other staff of the Consolidated School District at their Convocation at Greensboro Center Thursday morning, August 2 (see photo on Page 1).







Being part of the EPC – a Global Movement of Evangelical Presbyterian Churches - continues to challenge and to facilitate our commitment to Christ's Mission regionally, nationally, and internationally. As we connect further with EPC international missions sharing the Good News of Jesus to nations and people groups among whom Islam is the majority religion, we continue to pray for persecuted EPC missionaries, including Pastor Andrew Brunson. In July, after further frustrating developments and delays in Turkey's criminal trial of Pastor Andrew, he was – thankfully – finally allowed to leave his crowded prison cell and to go home under house arrest. Please continue to pray for Pastor Andrew, as we await possible further developments prior to the scheduled October resumption of his trial.

As Pastor Lifer and Elder Jack Forbus also reported at the Annual Congregational Meeting on July 22, FPC support will now be providing for the education and equipping of six (yes – 6!) church planters in 2018 for new churches with ministry outreach to people in India who do not know the saving light and truth of Jesus Christ. This is a remarkable development through the faithful giving of God's faithful stewards at FPC and, of course, all truly through his grace. All thanks be to Him!
